Signalment: 1-Year-Old Chestnut Thoroughbred Filly- 985100012150761

Lime Country Stud:

On the 7th of April 2020, just prior to the commencement of the Inglis Easter Yearling sale 'Gold Anthem '18' underwent a limited brief visual examination at Lime Country.

The horse was examined in the box and at rest and at the walk and trot. The examination consisted of the following:

- Assessment at the walk no evidence of lameness or neurologic deficits
- Assessment at the trot no evidence of lameness
- Assessment of limbs- The horse has multiple contusions to both forelimbs:
 - Left fore has moderate dorsal knee soft tissue swelling that is generalised oedema. There is no obvious pain on firm flexion of the knee.
 - o Right fore has multiple partial thickness abrasions over the radius and a small full thickness skin wound (5mm) and mild swelling over the mid lateral cannon bone which is not painful on firm palpation but has some mild drainage and appears at risk of developing an infection.

The horse has been started on a course of antibiotics (Penicillin) and anti-inflammatories.
